MEMBERSHIP INVOICES AND FEES 2017

Invoices have been distributed.

Membership fees unpaid as of <u>APRIL 5</u> will be charged a late fee of \$25*.

All members - it is your responsibility to ensure that your current address is provided to membership @nwtennis.com.

<u>Important</u>: Members are also reminded that the bylaws have been amended as follows:

The Executive, Junior, Intermediate and student fees are established at 50% of the regular annual fee e.g. \$95 for 2017.

*Members returning after not paying in a prior year, the following is an excerpt from the approved bylaws:

Transfer of membership and readmission after termination

2.10 No membership in any class is assignable or transferrable and no member who has ceased to be a member under the provisions of paragraphs 2.7 or 2.8 hereof shall be readmitted to membership except in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2.1 and 2.2 hereof.

However, a person who was previously a Regular Adult Member for a continuous period of three (3) years may be readmitted by the Board to membership without paying the full entrance fee, provided however such person shall pay a re-entrance fee equal to the lesser of the entrance fee for the year in which the person reapplies for membership and an amount that is equal to [number of years since the [person ceased being a member] x [25% of the entrance fee for the year in which the person reapplies].
