

EARLY Member Access to Junior Sunday Clinic Programs and INFO on Upcoming Adult Clinic Programs

Hi everyone – Registration for our newly offered **Junior Sunday Clinic Programs** is **AVAILABLE NOW** to NWTC Junior members and the children of Club members ONLY. As outlined in the information on the attached poster below, we are offering an Orange Ball Basic (Ages 8-10 years) and a Green Ball Basic (Ages 10-12 years) Clinic on Sunday afternoon, beginning in mid-May. You may choose to register your child in one of these introductory Clinics using the following links:

*** Please know that as a Club member, if you are registering your child but they are not already a NWTC Junior Member, there are required steps once you login to your ClubSpark account to access the member rate during registration.**

1. Once you hit the link, select **BOOK NOW**
2. **Sign in to your ClubSpark account** with your Email address/password
3. Under “Player details,” select **+ADD PLAYER**
4. Complete the required information under “Player Details” and select **CONFIRM PLAYER DETAILS**
5. The name of the added junior should now appear below the ClubSpark account holder’s name
6. Select **CHANGE** beside “Non-member” to identify the junior as a Member
7. **Select the box to the left of the junior player’s name** and ensure that the **Basket summary below** reflects the TOTAL COST at the member rate of \$157.50
8. Proceed to payment

If your child has friends who wish to register for one of these Clinics, but they or their family are not NWTC members, we ask that you wait for us to open access to them by way of general registration on our club website (www.nwtennis.com). Certainly, we would be happy for you to spread the word now on our upcoming Spring Clinics and please do ask friends to keep checking our Club website for general registration to open soon. However, the links that we are sharing now provide a portal into our ClubSpark system, and they are strictly for the use of Club members this week. We encourage you to take advantage of this early registration window.

Orange Ball Basic (Ages 8 – 10 years)

With an emphasis on fun, active participation and skill development, instruction will start with drills to improve technical and tactical skills and move toward implementation of these skills into point play. We use orange-dot balls for this program. No previous experience is needed.

Coach to Student Ratio: 1 to 6

Session 1.1 (7 classes – 7 hours total, including extra rainout day)

Date: Every Sunday, May 14th – June 25th

Time: 3:00 – 3:55 pm / Court 4

Cost: \$157.50/Member, \$183.75/Non-member

Green Ball Basic (Ages 10 – 12 years)

As with Orange Ball Basic, instruction will focus on skill development using modified courts and balls to make tennis easier and fun. No previous experience is needed.

Coach to Student Ratio: 1 to 6

Session 1.2 (7 classes – 7 hours total, including extra rainout day)

Date: Every Sunday, May 14th – June 25th

Time: 4:00 – 4:55 pm / Court 4

Cost: \$157.50/Member, \$183.75/Non-member
