Women's Div.2 was 4th of 9 teams; Women's Div.4 was 8th of 10 teams.

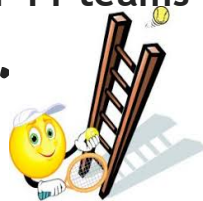
Men's A2 was 6th of 6 teams; B2 was 5th of 11 teams & C1 was 7th of 11 teams.
